### **Rookie of the Year**

**DESCRIPTION**—Members who are outstanding rookies

**ELIGIBILITY**—Recipients must have completed Basic Training/Probation in the year of the Banquet. (i.e., Probation finished between Jan 1 to Dec. 31 of 1997 for the 1997 Banquet held March of 1998). The start date of the recipient is not a concern as long as probation was completed in year of banquet.

**SELECTION**—Voted on by district members

### **Firefighter of the Year**

**DESCRIPTION**—This Award is given annually and is based upon outstanding or high activity and attendance to training and/or alarms as well as special events.

**ELIGIBILITY**—Any firefighter (not an officer) who is not eligible for Rookie of the Year.

**SELECTION**—Voted on by district members

### **Officer of the Year**

**DESCRIPTION**—This award is presented to the officer whose performance has been exceptional over the course of the past year.

**ELIGIBILITY**—Any officer who has completed one year of probation.

**SELECTION**—Voted on by district members

### **EMT of the Year**

**DESCRIPTION**—This Award is given annually and is based upon outstanding or high activity and attendance to EMS training and/or alarms as well as special EMS events.

**ELIGIBILITY**—Recipients must be a state certified EMT-B, I or P.

**SELECTION**—Voted on by district members

\* Any voting that results in two members receiving the most votes will result in co-winners. Nor more than two winners will be recognized in any one category per year. The fire chief will make the final choice in cases of more than two winners. Any ties in voting results for Officer of the Year will be decided by the fire chief.
