## Gene's Cooking Corner

### Chilled Angel Food Coconut Dessert

- 1 Angel Food Cake (chopped or torn in chunks)
- 2 small boxes coconut cream pudding
- 1 1/2 cup of milk
- 1 (8oz) pkg cream cheese
- 1/2 of (half-gallon) carton softened vanilla ice cream
- 1 container Cool Whip
- toasted coconut (if desired)

Layer cake pieces in 13x9" pan. Mix pudding, milk, cream cheese & ice cream, (add extra coconut if desired). Pour over angel food cake. Chill. Top with Cool Whip & toasted coconut. Keep refrigerated until ready to serve.

### ◆ SAFETY REMINDER:

When you respond to a wildland fire nylon gym shorts and a poly T-shirt or similar garments under wildland nomex are not appropriate. If you are likely to respond to the station in these types of clothing, have a pair of jeans or cotton sweats and a cotton shirt here to change into. Proper layering is paramount and required to protect you in a wildland/grass fire.
